•R4100-00 for day attendees

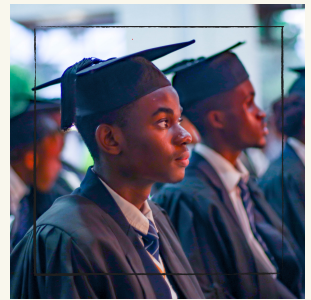
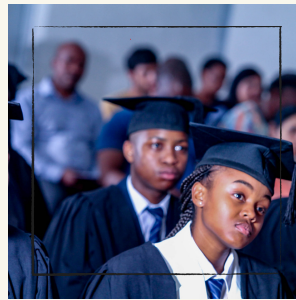
•R6150-00 for pupils requiring accommodation and meals at St John's College
