UMALUSI Accreditation Awarded

The UMALUSI Council for Quality Assurance in General and Further Education and Training sets and monitors standards for general and further education and training in South Africa in accordance with the National Qualifications Framework Act 67 of 2008, as amended, and the General and Further Education and Training Quality Assurance Act 58 of 2001, as amended. In order to issue learners with certificates that are credible, UMALUSI: develops and evaluates qualifications and curricula to ensure that they are of the expected standard; moderates assessment to ensure that it is fair, valid and reliable; accredits providers of education and training, and assessment; conducts research to ensure educational quality; and verifies the authenticity of certificates.

A large part of UMALUSI's mandate is to quality assure independent schools. This is a lengthy, thorough assessment of all aspects of the school, including but not limited to curriculum delivery, assessment, examinations, facilities, financial health, health and safety etc.

After a great deal of preparation and patience, we have been awarded accreditation status with UMALUSI to offer the National Curriculum Statement (NCS) in grades 8 – 12 leading to the National Senior Certificate (NSC). Our official accreditation number is 24 SCH01 01147. Well done to all staff involved in making this happen, it is a really big deal.

We wish our Hindu Community a very Happy New Year tomorrow.








