Ridgeway College once again celebrates outstanding performance from our Matric Class of 2021 in their National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations written with the International Examinations Board (IEB).

Despite the continued challenges of the pandemic, the pupils of Ridgeway once again produced some excellent results. Our over all pass rate came in at 97,22% with 75% of our pupils achieving a Bachelor Degree pass. A testament to the hard work of our teachers, the diligence of our pupils and the focused support from our parents.

Our Top Achiever (Dede Bessong) achieved 7 distinctions: Accounting, Afrikaans (FAL), English (HL), Life Orientation, Life Sciences, Mathematics and Physical Sciences.

Tendani Sinyosi and Tinashe Kujinga each received 6 distinctions. Tendani achieved distinctions in Accounting, Afrikaans (FAL), Life Orientation, Life Sciences, Mathematics and Physical Sciences.
