REGULATIONS REPEAL

The Government Gazette (No. 11447) issued 22 June 2022 includes the repeal of Regulations 16A, 16B and 16C of the Regulations Relating to the Surveillance and the Control of Notifiable Medical Conditions.

As such:

•The national mandatory mask requirement for indoor spaces is no longer in force and therefore learners and staff are no longer required by law to wear these indoors or on any form of public transport. This includes classrooms, halls and passageways.

•Gatherings in respect of any school events are not limited and/or do not require any vaccination and/or test documentation.

Your child is welcome to continue to wear a mask to school/class should they wish to.
