Allow me to update you all on a few school related matters.

- Grade 7 Leadership Programme launched

· School Tours postponed

We had our annual educational tours planned for the start of term 2. This will no longer happen in Term 2. In the light of the current alert level 3, tours will be postponed until a later date. We have tentatively planned for dates in Term 3 during the month of September and will keep parents updated going forward.

• Extra-curricular activities

In an earlier Newsletter, I shared a 2-week interim extra-curricular programme with all parents. This has now come to an end. Please find included the extra-curricular time table for Grade 1-7 that will be used until the end of Term 1. Please share this with your children and bring them up to speed of what will be on offer as from next week, 15 February onwards.

#### • School Traffic

I am well aware of the frustrations around the traffic in the afternoons when picking up your child/children. We have limited parking available on the grounds as it is. In the past many of our students would arrive in taxis, public buses and private vehicles. However, we have seen the increase in private vehicles, mainly because more parents are using their own transport as opposed to taxis and/or public buses. The enormous amount of rain has also contributed to our internal roads to be less than user friendly, limiting us even further with space to park without getting stuck in the mud. We have tried various options before to improve the traffic flow, such as staggered pick up times, however, many people have children spread between the three campuses and because the ECD and Prep closes earlier than the College, they end up waiting at the school for the younger siblings to be collected first. In some cases parents also take their time to depart once they have picked up their children, some parents/drivers park in unfavourable spaces which ends up blocking the main road in and out of the school. I can only ask for us all to work together and make the most of what we have available. I am sure that once we come to the end of the raining season, things will improve and allow for bigger areas to be available to park without getting stuck in the mud. We have measured up all the internal roads of the school to obtain a costing to put gravel down and to compact the internal school road. This information was submitted to our school owners for their consideration.

# School Athletics: Ridgeway Races

A reminder that our Inter-house athletics will take place on 25 and 26 February during the school day. Unfortunately, as stipulated previously, no spectators will be allowed on both days. This is to make sure that we, as a school, comply to all Covid regulations as well as the guidelines in terms of school sport during alert level 3.
